

FOSTER CARE CHILD CARE



Thank you for caring for a child in the custody of the Secretary of the Department for Children and Families (DCF). Beginning **July 1, 2019**, a new child care supplement program, Foster Care Child Care (FC-CC), is opening for foster caregivers. This new program features benefits specifically tailored to your needs while caring for a child in foster care.

WHO

Three groups must apply for the new FC-CC Program:

1. Any licensed foster parent or non-related kin who is currently obtaining child care through the child's case management provider.
2. Any relative foster caregiver who currently has an EBT card through DCF's Economic & Employment Support Services for child care services.
3. Any foster caregiver who has new child care needs beginning July 1, 2019 or later.

HOW

Starting May 24th, obtain a FC-CC application from:

- <http://www.dcf.ks.gov/services/PPS/Pages/PPSservices.aspx> under Foster Care Services; or
- your sponsoring agency (for licensed family foster homes); or
- your child's foster care Case Manager.

Follow the directions on the application, which explain what to expect.
